Since its opening in 1978, the Et Cetera Shop has depended on volunteers. In 2024, 101 volunteers contributed 25,897 hours, enabling \$109,000 in donations: \$57,500 to MCC, \$5,000 to MDS Hurricane Helene Relief, and \$46,500 to local charities. The big goal for 2025, is the relocation of Builders Bargains and Medical Bargains which will double the floor space, improve parking, and a fenced in back area to provide better storage and processing.
